A38 Carkeel Roundabout

General Overview

A bitesize guide

Why are we doing this?

Carkeel junction is currently over capacity, and severe congestion is experienced at peak rush hour periods during the working week, and in the summer. This traffic congestion is expected to be further exacerbated by increased traffic volumes associated with future growth in Saltash and Plymouth to 2030.

What are the benefits?

The scheme when completed will provide better access and improved journey times for commuters and visitors. This will be achieved from a larger signalised roundabout, with the approaches and exits realigned to increase capacity.

This in turn will support the economic regeneration of Saltash and the wider area through the management of congestion, which will in turn facilitate the delivery of the Local Plan allocations for future housing.

Construction Overview



Duration: 18 Months

Start Date: 12th September 2016

Access and road Closures: Access will be maintained throughout. There will be various night time closure periods throughout the scheme, which will be sign posted on site, as well as the project webpage.

Diversion (during closure period): From Carkeel, travel via A388 to A38 Stoketon Cross, and then travel Eastbound along A38 into Saltash via Latchbrook. The opposite direction applies travelling from Saltash to Carkeel.
