	order to meet the Local Plan housing target and 'the actual level of proposed development within the NDP is very small: NDP Policy NP1 proposes a development boundary at Saltash and the supporting evidence to this policy sets out useful information demonstrating that, although there appears to be large gaps in this, the NDP does not facilitate development in these locations' i.e. it does not facilitate development in any way beyond the existing presumption in favour of sustainable development that could generate additional run-off. Clearly therefore EN's assumption is unsound. To meet ENs objection we could simply delete the development boundary, which would have no effect on the likelihood of development in the built up area, but would render additional development more likely in areas adjoining the built up area, so producing the very issue that EN fear.  If it's simply a matter of the boundary being unclear vis-a-vis the SPA/SAC, then it would be much easier to correct that at this consultation draft stage than proceed to SEA.  It was agreed that SB-F prepare a letter to Cornwall Council based upon the content of his note for approval by the Chairman. The letter would include a request for a meeting to discuss matters if required.  It was also agreed that if the conclusion reached from 2. above was the need for a full SEA and HRA, then DY and SB-F were given approval to make an application to "Locality" to commission and grant fund (e. £6k)independent assessments.  "Locality is the national membership network supporting local community organisations to be strong and successful."  SB-F advised that should the SEA and HRA assessments be required that their preparation would not delay the Reg. 14 public consultation.	SB-F DY SB-F DY
