Development: Proposed helipad and forward operating base to service the Fleet Helicopter Support Unit, comprising construction of helicopter landing site, demolition of three existing buildings, modification of part of an existing building, relocation of security fencing, construction of a new building to replace those demolished, and construction of a fuel bowser park.

Date received: 10.07.2015

It was resolved to **RECOMMEND** that **Saltash Town Council is fully appreciative of the need for the new Helicopter Forward Operating Base and has no objections to this application.**

It is suggested that, particularly during the initial operation of this facility, noise monitoring be carried out close to Bishop Cornish Primary School and Saltash.net Secondary School in the same way as is proposed for Riverside School and the proposed planning condition in paragraph 8.7 of the Noise Impact Assessment Addendum should also be applied to those two schools.

Obviously, if the noise monitoring shows a negligible impact in these areas, no further action will be required and the planning condition will have no significant effect.

If noise levels are significant the appropriate operational mitigations in 8.5 and 8.6 of the Noise Impact Assessment Addendum and the proposed planning condition in paragraph 8.7 of the Noise Impact Assessment Addendum should also be applied to those two schools.

These proposals are in view of the fact that helicopters will be encouraged to arrive and depart using the NE Flight Path and although the two schools are further from the helicopter pad than Riverside School they are close to the axis of NW Flight path and particularly the location where helicopters will be changing course when both landing and taking off.

There is little in the way of obstruction between the flight path turning point and the schools themselves to moderate any helicopter noise.

Noise monitoring would allow modifications to be made to the arrival and departure Flight Paths, if required, to maintain noise levels below those recommended in the Noise Impact Assessment Addendum.

The results of this noise monitoring and any subsequent flight path changes should be advised to Saltash Town Council.
