

## Seagull Advice

There have been reports of seagull nuisance in the town.

Most gulls are protected by law from interference or action to control them but by working with your neighbours you should be able to improve the situation.

- Stop easy access to human food.
- Don't leave lids off bins.
- Don't put rubbish sacks out before 7.00am on the day of collection.
- Use seagull proof reusable sacks (available to purchase from the library).
- Don't drop litter.
