Following the loss of yet another local last weekend and yet another attempt 2 days later I would like to formally request that this item be discussed at the next Town Council Meeting as an agenda item.

The petition started 2 years ago has now exceeded 15,000 signatures and continues to rise calling for anti climb barriers on the bridge to prevent further attempts. Whilst I appreciate the bridge does not fall under your remit or control I would like to strongly point out that this issue has adversely affected many local people for over 20 years now and I for one as a member of the local voting public would like to know why the town council has not been supportive to date in joining their voice in supporting the protection of local vulnerable members of the public within our society. I have gathered significant international evidence proving barriers do work and attempts are not displaced to other sites within the locality and would be happy to share this with you given the opportunity.
