## Training for City, Town and Parish Councils: Tackling littering, fly tipping and dog fouling

Dear City, Town and Parish Councils,

I am pleased to take this opportunity to invite you to one of our free training sessions for City, Town, and Parish councillors and clerks for our new enforcement tool for tackling littering, fly tipping and dog fouling.

We know that 58% of our residents think that environmental nuisances like littering, fly tipping and dog fouling are a very or fairly big problem in their local area (Residents Survey 2017).

Working in partnership with Launceston Town Council and Bodmin Town Council, we have developed a non-confrontational enforcement tool for tackling littering, fly tipping and dog fouling issues. This new enforcement tool empowers City, Town and Parish Councils to take action and bring offenders to account.
