TOWN CENTRE REGENERATION

ACTIONS AS A RESULT OF MEETING HELD 12/8/19

- 1. The Chamber to pursue an application to the S.106 panel for the creation of a BOGOF (buy one get one free) with respect to car parking in the town centre car parks for the period 1/11/19 to 31/3/20 so that customers can get 2 hours for 50p.
- 2. A proposal to set up a CIC of interested parties to employ professionals, subject to funding availability, to organise and manage leisure/market events on a monthly basis in and around Fore Street.
- 3. Through Saltash Town Council, to pursue a pedestrian crossing across Callington Road to give better access to Victoria Gardens.
- 4. To organise promotion relating to the town centre via a brochure which may be in conjunction with the proposal being worked on by Councillor Sarah Martin.
- 5. To ascertain special attractions, e.g. steam trains passing through Saltash, which can be used to attract visitors into Fore Street.
- 6. Carry out further research into the possibility of a land train to link the waterfront with the town centre and the railway station in conjunction with the possibility of a water taxi linking to Sutton Harbour.
- 7. To liaise with Saltash Heritage and landlords of empty shops with a view to having displays in the windows to uplift the image of the shops.
- 8. To take note of the emerging Cornwall Council policy on the Vitality of High Street.
