THE YOUNG PEOPLE ARE INFORMED OF JY OPEN ACCESS SESSIONS AND MADE AWARE OF OTHER YOUTH PRIVISIONS AVAILABLE TO THEM WITHIN SALTASH AREA, THERE MAIN FEED BACK HOWEVER IS THAT AT SALTMILL THEY CAN DO AS THEY PLEASE.

SOME WOULD LIKE SALTMILL TO BE MADE SAFER, AND HAVE MORE FRIENDLY FEEL, ALSO WE ARE LOOKING TO PROVIDE SAFETY EQUIPMENT DOWN THERE FOR THOSE WHO NEED IT, WE ARE HOPING TO HAVE A MEETING WITH GW AND CORNWALL COUNCIL AT POSSIBLY SUPPORTING SALTMILL SKATEPARK FURTHER FOR 2020 DELIEVRING ON REQUESTS OF THE YOUNG PEOPLE AND PARENTS WITHIN THE TOWN.
