

Annual Report for Chamber of Commerce

During the last 12 months we have had numerous briefings attached are a few, we have had talks from the Chairman of the Bridge joint committee to update us on the work schedule and the increase of the tolls. CYBER SECURITY to help support businesses and to keep the computers and software safe. TIME CREDITS which is a scheme that Cornwall Council have started for voluntary payment services.

Our Chamber has also been very active on local meetings attending the Safer Saltash. Liaising with other Chambers in Cornwall. Supporting Saltash Fore Street regeneration and also supporting the Christmas light festival.

We have been the leading group in the installing of a 5 month period of reduction in car parking in Saltash from November until the end of March reducing the parking to 50p for 2 hours (buy one get one free) with support from the 106 fund that has been provided from the development at Gilston Rd .

We have also been involved with objections against the following, 1)increase in car parking charges 2)Toll increase on the Tamar bridge
3) increase on licensing fees on taxis
