

**Decision: SALTASH TOWN COUNCIL DECISION: Dated 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 via The Emergency Planning Determination Procedures.**

Consent to reduce carry out various works on lateral branches and lower crown lateral branches. full crown thinning by 10% on Lucombe Oak (T1) Remove three scared small branches and prune back protruding spur to main stem on Yew (T2) and Reduce height of all over hanging branches on Yew (T3) on trees within Conservation Area.
