Enter the full name of the council is requesting that you bring to the attention of all your fellow Members of Parliament, the Chief Constable of the Devon and Cornwall Police and the Leader of Cornwall Council that this council is concerned for the health and long-term welfare of all the members of the public that it represents.

Happily, the people of this community live in an area of the country that has been least affected by the Covid-19 epidemic, whist its three main industries, Agriculture, Fisheries and Tourism, have been three of the hardest hit in economic and employment terms.

The low infection rate has largely been achieved by the public's loyalty and steadfast obedience to the principles of isolation as laid down in recent Covid-19 legislation.

If this situation is going to continue, this council feels that the principles of "lockdown" should not be relaxed until there is strong evidence that a second spike of Covid-19 infection would not happen.

This council, along with many others, is fully aware that tourists and others with second homes here in the area have flaunted the law making the journey to Cornwall in the hope of safeguarding themselves in isolation here. Many of these journeys are made during the hours of darkness and are therefore going largely undetected. This is leaving our police force and Cornwall Council with an ever-increasing register of complaints, swamping their ability to take the necessary action to curtail the situation.
