Due to the current situation Saltash Town Council will unfortunately not be holding an official Christmas Light Switch on event this year but instead Saltash Town Council Members agreed a bright Fore Street with Christmas Lights across many Council sites.

Following the meeting of the Christmas Lights and Town Events Sub-Committee held on 7<sup>th</sup> October it was agreed by Members that Saltash Town Council will be extending their Christmas Light display to include Lower Fore Street down to the Guildhall. We are also working towards lighting up the Guildhall during the Festive Period. The switch on of the lights will go ahead late afternoon of Friday 13<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

In addition it was also agreed to add lighting at the Waterfront and install a Christmas tree. A Christmas tree will also be displayed at the Library and external lighting at Longstone Depot.

Saltash Town Council are also joining residents and local businesses in decorating the Guildhall windows as part of the Window Wanderland Festival and are working with local youth groups to take part in the window displays which we hope to be in place by Monday 30<sup>th</sup> November.

We understand this has been a difficult year and hope that the Town Councils festive spirits boost morale within the town and working together with local businesses we can still offer residents and visitors of our high street a fantastic local and warm welcome.
