Meet Your Councillor - Councillor Mike Parker - East Ward Saltash



Councillor Mike Parker moved to Saltash from Oxfordshire in 1994, together with wife Norma and their two sons, Lewis and Ashley, who have both grown up and been educated in Saltash.

Mike has served the Saltash community in various ways, including more than twenty years as an on-call Firefighter and more latterly as one of four Councillors for Saltash East Ward, which includes the Waterside, Waterfront and Fore Street. Mike also runs Saltash Fire Cadets.

Having previously worked for the Ministry of Defence and in the building supplies trade, including running his own business, Mike brings considerable expertise and enthusiasm to his current role as Chair of the Saltash Town Council Services Committee, which oversees much of the day to day provision of services provided to both residents and visitors to the town he is proud to call home.

The role of the Services committee has expanded and continues to expand under the stewardship of Cllr Parker, as services have been and continue to be devolved from Cornwall Council.
