Wild Meadows in Saltash

Saltash Town Council will be continuing to promote wild meadows in suitable places across the town.

Two new locations have been chosen to be planted with yellow rattle seed. These are Primrose Walk, Pillmere and around the Celtic Cross which marks the Cornwall Devon boundary at the entrance to the Tamar Bridge.

Yellow rattle seed is an attractive grassland annual that suppresses the growth of grass giving other wild plants the chance to flourish. It will take two-three years for the plant to dominate and the wild meadow to really flourish. The plant attracts bees and other insects to the area and will be key to establishing wild meadows in Saltash.
