A new Aldi food store for Saltash

Aldi, the award-winning discount food retailer, is excited to announce plans for a new high-quality food store on land west of Callington Road, Saltash.

Aldi is preparing a full application for submission to Cornwall Council.

We are keen to consult with the community ahead of submission so that we can hear your views and take those into account as we finalise our proposals. We will then report the outcome of this consultation in a Statement of Community Involvement submitted with the planning application and encourage you to participate and provide your thoughts.

Our proposal for Saltash offers:

- A total investment of around £10 million: benefiting Saltash and the wider area
- A new community food store: improving access to Aldi's award-winning range of fresh, healthy, affordable food
- Creating approximately 40 new local jobs for the new Aldi store, paid at a sector-leading rate, above the National Living Wage
- Additional employment opportunities created during construction and supported through the supply chain
- Over 100 free customer car parking spaces including accessible spaces and parent & child spaces
- Electric vehicle charging points with additional infrastructure installed so further points can be added in the future
- Attractive landscaping incorporated around the site to improve its appearance and provide screening for neighbours

Improved choice for Saltash

A new food store will provide better access to Aldi's award-winning range of fresh, healthy, affordable food meaning improved choice for people in Saltash.

It will reduce the need to make car journeys to supermarkets further afield - easing pressure on Carkeel Roundabout and other roads and junctions in Saltash.

Being a good neighbour

We are proud to be at the heart of local communities across the country. To continue our community-led culture, we have set out a number of "neighbour-friendly" practices:

Aldi aims to recruit its store managers and store colleagues from the local area, which enables them to react quickly and sympathetically to any local issues.

Aldi stocks a carefully selected range of approximately 1,800 core exclusive products, compared with larger supermarkets that may stock over 10 times that number of product lines. As a result, an Aldi food store will require only three to four deliveries per day.

Aldi's unique delivery system enables products to be transferred from the vehicle straight to store, without the need for external movement - minimising the potential for any disruption.

Local jobs

Aldi aims to provide flexible jobs for local people. If approved, a new Aldi food store would provide approximately 40 new local jobs, paid at an industry leading rate.

Aldi offers training and career growth opportunities within the company. Aldi's pay is higher than the Government's National Living Wage. Store Assistants receive a minimum hourly rate of £13.02 (increasing to £13.35 from 1st March 2026).

Further employment opportunities would also be created during the construction period and in the supply chain.

Aldi has been named as the UK's Cheapest Supermarket for 2025 by consumer champion *Which?*.

Aldi focuses on quality rather than quantity, stocking a carefully selected range of groceries that shoppers need. This efficient approach allows Aldi to pass on savings to customers.
