Saltash Town Council Waterside Security Trial

Saltash Town Council have invested in a Waterside security trial, in response to growing concerns around anti-social behaviour.

City Security Plymouth Officers will be patrolling the Waterside area, from Jubilee Pontoon to the Sailing Club, from 2pm until 10pm throughout the summer holidays.

This trial forms part of the Town Council's ongoing commitment to maintaining a welcoming and safe town for everyone. The initiative follows concerns about anti-social behaviour in parts of the area, and aims to provide a positive, visible presence during the busy summer period.

The Security Officers will focus on engagement with residents, visitors and businesses, offering assistance where needed and helping to promote responsible use of the area. They are also trained to take day and overnight pontoon payments by card on behalf of the Town Council.

Saltash Town Council would like to encourage members of the public to interact with the Security Officers, as they will be able to answer questions and gather feedback about the pontoon service and wider Waterside area. This is important, as these views help the Town Council to identify opportunities for future improvements and initiatives.

During the trial period, please feel free to get in touch with Saltash Town Council to share your thoughts and feedback. Updates will be delivered through the Town Council's website and social media channels over the coming weeks, with data to be shared once the trial is complete.

Saltash Town Council look forward to exploring the effectiveness of this security trial on keeping Saltash residents and visitors safe.

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Notes To Editor

Saltash Town Council forms the third tier of local government and works with Cornwall Council who are our Unitary Authority. We are the largest Town Council in the south-east area of Cornwall.

The Town Council is committed to providing excellence in the Services and Facilities which it delivers. We aim to be responsive, accessible, and transparent in our approach and in the work delivered.

There are sixteen Councillors representing three Wards – Essa, Tamar and Trematon. Councillors are elected from the community every four years. Spaces are filled via by-elections, or by means of the Town Council choosing new Councillors via co-option.

The Chairman and Deputy Chairman are elected by Members of the Town Council annually at the Annual Town Council meeting held in May. The Chairman also undertakes the role of Mayor representing the Town Council and community at official engagements, with their consort.
